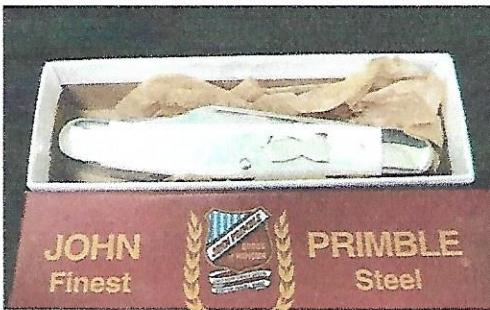
## May Show

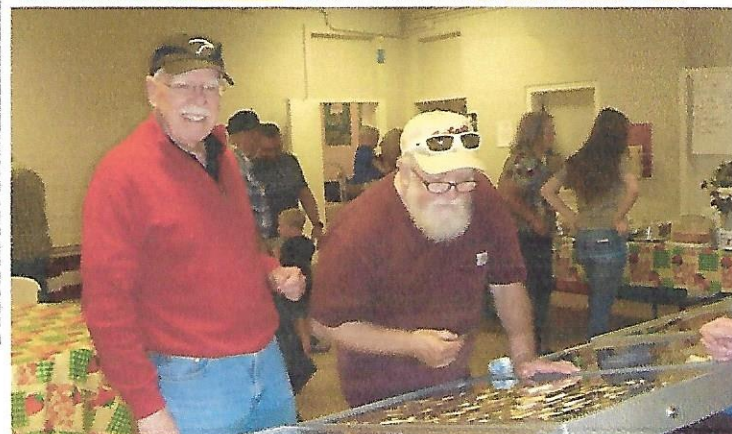

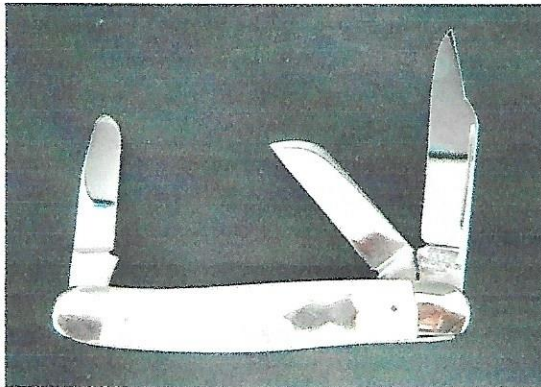

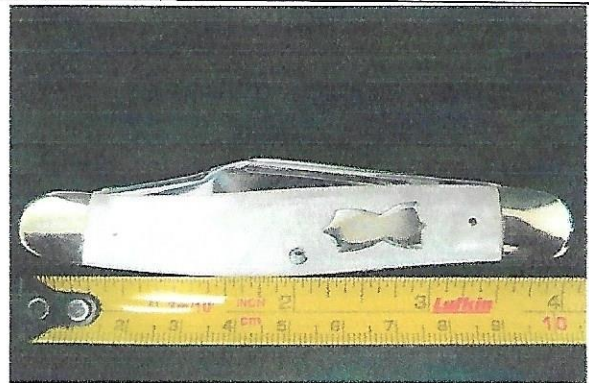
